NORTHEAST KINGDOM CHAMBER OF COMMERCE COMMITTEES -

The NEK Board of Trustees has established committees to aid the staff in areas of greatest interest. The committees are made up of members of the board, other chamber members and staff. We encourage members to become involved as members of a committee or by offering suggestions.

SPECIAL PROJECTS COMMITTEE

- Identify special projects or events to raise funds for Chamber operations
- Coordinate and implement fund-raising projects and programs

The Special Projects Committee's successes include the Annual Chamber Super Raffle and the "Drop the Ball" golf ball drop.

COLORS OF THE KINGDOM FESTIVAL COMMITTEE

- Determine and help organize festival activities
- Serve as volunteer for the Colors of the Kingdom Festival
- Promote increased attendance to the event

Planning of the St. Johnsbury Fall Foliage Festival by the NEK Chamber began in 1995. In 2010, the event's name was changed to Colors of the Kingdom Festival. The event has become a tradition for many, yet it continues to evolve in order to attract new audiences. In recent years, the committee has expanded the festival beyond its original Main Street location, added a themed parade and adjusted the date to coordinate with other organizations in the area. It now serves as the kick-off event for fall happenings in the area.

MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

The membership committee looks at how the chamber positions itself to its members and visitors. Its sub-committees include:

- **Tourism** the tourism subcommittee reviews and suggests needed changes for the following tourism-related brochures/programs: tourism/services brochures, travel show and web site
- Membership how to attract and retain membership through various initiatives and events
- **Web site -** oversees web site, the most extensive in the Kingdom, covering visitor, relocation, business relocation, member and resource guide information.

This committee is very active. They meet monthly and continuously provide great new ideas and improvements to current projects. The Membership Fair, "Top Ten Reasons to Join the Chamber" magnets, Business Survival Tool Kit and Business-to-Business Networking meetings are just a few of the initiatives recently established by this committee.

FINANCE COMMITTEE

- Assist Accounting Manager, Executive Director and Treasurer in the preparation of annual budget
- Meet as is necessary to assess financial status of chamber
- Review all items relating to possible revenue and expense streams prior to general board review/approval
- Investigate investment options for the chamber
- Review capital expenditures and determine long-term planning options with designated funds
- Determine audit review schedules.

ECONOMIC GROWTH COMMITTEE

- Identify seminar topics and organize seminars
- Act as clearinghouse for information relating to economic development issues & recruitment strategies
- Work in liaison with local economic development entities and report back as needed to board of trustees.

YOUNG PROFESSIONAL GROUP (ages 25-40)

- Discuss the challenges of doing business in the Northeast Kingdom as a young professional
- Share ideas and success stories to support one another
- Review what the chamber can do to support young professionals.

GOOD NEWS FOR CHAMBER MEMBERS!

NATIONAL STUDY SHOWS BENEFITS OF JOINING CHAMBERS OF COMMERCE

A national study by The Schapiro Group, an Atlanta-based market research firm, reveals a number of important findings about how consumers and business owners perceive the local chamber of commerce and the businesses that are their members.

CONSUMERS ARE MORE LIKELY TO BUY GOODS AND SERVICES FROM CHAMBER OF COMMERCE MEMBERS.

For example:

- When consumers know that a business is a member of the local chamber, they are 44% more likely to think favorably about it.
- Consumers who are told that a business is a chamber member are 51% more likely to be highly aware of it and 57% more likely to think positively of its local reputation.
- Consumers are 63% more likely to buy goods and services in the future from a company that they believe is a member of the local chamber of commerce.



MEMBER LOYALTY: CHAMBER MEMBERS BUY FROM OTHER CHAMBER MEMBERS

The study also has good news for businesses that sell to other businesses.

• When business decision-makers believe that a business is a chamber member, they are **37%** more likely to think favorably of the business, **51%** more likely to be highly aware of it, **58%** more likely to think positively of its local reputation, and **59%** more likely to buy goods and services from it.

CHAMBERS SUPPORT THE LOCAL ECONOMY

Supporting the previous findings, the study also reveals a positive perception for the local chamber itself:

• Regarding the chamber's impact on the local economy, **82%** of respondents believe that the local chamber of commerce helps create jobs and promotes local economic development.

The results of the Schapiro study are clear: Positive perception increases among consumers and business owners when a business is identified as a member of the local chamber of commerce.

NATIONAL STUDY:

Consumers are 63 percent more likely to buy products and services from businesses that are members of chambers of commerce. And 82 percent of those who responded to the survey believe that chambers of commerce help create jobs and promote local economic development.

THE BENEFITS OF BEING A NORTHEAST KINGDOM CHAMBER MEMBER

The Northeast Kingdom Chamber of Commerce, a chamber based out of St. Johnsbury with about 375 members, has business partnerships throughout the tri-county region known as the Northeast Kingdom - the counties of Caledonia, Essex and Orleans. The Northeast Kingdom Chamber is the largest and only full-service chamber in the region, handling travel promotion, community/economic development, legislative/governmental relations, business training and promotion of regional projects. The NEK Chamber displays member brochures in our brochure racks at the Green Mountain Mall.

REFERRALS

The NEK Chamber handles an estimated 60,000 phone, mail, relocation/business relocation and visitor inquiries per year. These inquiries result from strong and aggressive advertising, brochure production and distribution efforts, visitor services and coordination with other chambers of commerce and business associations. The chamber also sends out hundreds of relocation packets each year.

THE NORTHEAST KINGDOM'S NEWLY REDESIGNED WEB SITE

As a member of the Northeast Kingdom Chamber, members are given a <u>free listing, description, picture and web</u> <u>site & e-mail links</u> on the web site, the most extensive in the region. Visitors to our web site can find detailed tourism, relocation/business relocation, regional, business and chamber information. And the site is one of the Kingdom's best web resource guides, hands down, for tourism and business inquiries. A site redesign in 2011 has included many improvements, including more streamlined routes to find the information you need. And each and every page of the new web site has been professionally optimized to ensure the site attracts as many visitors as possible. Chamber members can promote their businesses through reasonably priced web banner ads and enhanced chamber listings. Check us out on Facebook, Twitter and the chamber's blog. See pages 18-19.

ELECTRONIC NEWSLETTERS

The chamber sends notices to its members electronically about every two weeks. The newsletter includes information on events, member news and achievements, workshop details and chamber updates. Each is distributed to more than 500 businesspeople within the region. Chamber members can submit materials to the newsletter for free. This is a great way to promote your business to the greater chamber membership <u>at no cost</u>. In addition, members may place a logo style ad, including a hyper-link to their web site from the newsletter at a low cost.

MEMBERSHIP DIRECTORY

The Northeast Kingdom Chamber publishes an 80-page directory of chamber members that is distributed to members and to individuals, both locally and in response to requests coming from all over the nation. Members get a <u>free listing</u> in the directory and the opportunity to advertise in the publication at low cost. The Annual Membership Directory is also located online and updated frequently on the chamber web site, <u>www.nekchamber.com</u>.

PUBLICATIONS

The Northeast Kingdom Chamber prints and distributes more than <u>50,000 brochures</u> per year. The chamber aggressively promotes its own members and region through its brochures and web site. The chamber believes membership in the Northeast Kingdom Chamber and its initiatives and the additional association with the Northeast Kingdom Travel & Tourism Association makes a great one-two marketing/promotional punch for members.

Tourism & Services Guide & Map - About 50,000 printed each year. Distributed to all rest areas, all tourism/relocation inquiries, co-op advertising efforts, mailings and travel & trade shows, etc.

SEMINARS AND WORKFORCE TRAINING

Classes and training are done in conjunction with area business and professional people, as well as guest experts on subjects of interest to our members. Please let us know if you would like to hold a seminar on a particular topic or would like to use our conference room/business resource center for an employee training.

EVENTS & ACTIVITIES

The Northeast Kingdom Chamber sponsors and organizes a number of events throughout the year including:

- Annual Meeting Held in late winter. Features a business speaker and awards to members for business improvements.
- Monthly Legislative Breakfasts / Chamber Briefings Held the last Monday of each month during the legislative session. Hear updates from our local legislators and get the chance to ask questions.
- Business For Business Networking Sessions Gives chamber members the opportunity to network with fellow businesses on their services & products.

- Colors of the Kingdom Festival A one-day event in mid-September, featuring local culture, nature highlights and area history to kick off the foliage season, held in conjunction with numerous St. Johnsbury organizations. Upwards of 2,000 to 3,000 visitors and residents take part in the festivities.
- **Business Celebration** A luncheon to celebrate our local business accomplishments. About 20 business representatives give a brief presentation of their recent achievements. A "Business Person of the Year" is also awarded. Held in November.
- **Citizen of the Year** Held each spring. Celebrates the good deeds of a local citizen. Nominations are sought the beginning of each year.
- Super Raffle The chamber's biggest fund-raiser, held in July, with more than \$5,000 raised for the chamber in one night. 100 tickets are sold, with each ticket holder receiving a prize. A fun evening of friends, food and prizes.
- Ribbon Cuttings Held on an ongoing basis, to celebrate businesses opening in the area.
- **Business Roundtable Sessions** An issues-related forum, giving companies the opportunity to address business concerns that the chamber may help to address. Held as needed.
- Membership Benefit Forums Highlighting the many advantages of NEK Chamber membership. Held as needed
- After-Hours Mixers Held quarterly at member businesses. Includes music, food and prizes.
- And many other events and activities.


SAVING MONEY / PURCHASING POWER / POWER IN NUMBERS



- NEK Chamber Bulk Mailing Guidelines -

The NEK Chamber holds a Presorted Standard Bulk Mail Permit with the St. Johnsbury Post Office. The permit is renewed each year to allow us, and you, access to lower postage rates on large quantity mailings. There are many variables in preparing a bulk mailing, however, here are some of the basic guidelines. If you are interested in using this service through the NEK Chamber, please contact our office in advance to review your options and possible savings.

Questions to ask:

1. Do I have enough pieces?

A bulk mailing consists of 200 or more alike pieces to US addresses.

2. Do I have enough time?

A bulk mailing may take a little extra time to prepare, as well as, extra time to mail. Considered a third-class mailing, the post office may retain the mailing for up to 2 weeks. Be aware of this if your mailing is timely.

3. How do I prepare the mailing?

We ask that you fully assemble your mailing, using our permit number in the place of a postage stamp. You may have the permit printed on the materials or use our rubber stamp to apply it manually.

Delivery addresses must be complete and verified within the last 95 days. If you have not recently verified that your addresses are correct, please print "Return Requested" under the return address. There will be additional postage charged for pieces returned to you. If you do not choose this method, any pieces that are unable to be mailed will be tossed away. Please let us know what method you have used to check your addresses.

If you are mailing a newsletter or folded piece without an envelope, secure the <u>top edge</u> with seals or tape (<u>no staples</u>). Organize the pieces in zip code order.

Count how many pieces there are in your mailing.

4. How do I mail the pieces?

Bring the fully assembled mailing, in zip code order, with a full piece count to the NEK Chamber office. (Please notify us in advance when you will be dropping it off so we can fit it into our schedule.)

Our staff will organize the mailing into the appropriate categories for the type of mailing, verify the count and calculate the postage. This can take either one hour or several hours, depending on the size and type of mailing, as well as, the accuracy used in preparing it.

When the mailing is ready for the post office, we will call you with the postage amount. You pick it up from our office and bring it to the St. Johnsbury Post Office with the completed paperwork and payment.

5. How much does it cost?

We charge a \$25 permit usage fee per mailing, payable to the NEK Chamber. This flat fee is used to off-set the annual permit fee and staff time used.

The actual postage amount varies, but is a substantial savings over first class postage. Postage is calculated on the size and weight of the mailing piece.

- a. If it is a regular, letter-size, it will usually fall into the \$.265/pc. and \$.281/pc. rate categories. These two rates depend on the number of pieces to a mailing area. (Rates current as of June 2012.)
- b. If it is a larger piece or "flat" the rate can vary greatly, depending on the number of pieces to a mailing area and the weight of each piece. (For example: a 4oz flat can cost between \$.386 and \$.537, depending on how many of these pieces being sent to a zip code area.)
